Don't take our word for it, though – like the president of a decade ago, you are The Decider.

SPICY & AROMATIC WHITES

GERMAN RIESLING

In a bit of Darwinian poetry, it is thought that many of the best wines in the world are produced in some of the most marginal climates, where the vines must struggle to survive. Germany fits right into that trope: it has historically been too cold for grapes to properly ripen; and the picturesque riverbanks where vineyards are planted are too steep for men to walk. The vines fight to take root on these rocky, dangerous slopes; but once secure they can produce some of the most dramatically exciting white wines.

German Riesling is not necessarily sweet, but it is always fruit-forward on the nose with bright, refreshing acidity on the finish. As the wines age, they take on a honeyed quality and the flavors become more concentrated; for example, the 2011 Selbach-Oster both smells and tastes of apricot, while the 2003 Hexamer smells and tastes of dried apricot—and a whole lot of other stuff.

These wines are great with food, great as an aperitif, great in place of dessert. Did we mention that they are great with food? The cold climate helps guarantee extraordinarily high acidity from a grape with naturally high acid; and all that acidity means they work well at the table with just about anything you throw their way. As *The Wire* tells us, ‘The Germans are a hard-headed people, but you can’t beat them for craft.’

THE WORLD OF ROSE

Is there a more universal symbol of Summer than a bottle of rose chilling in an ice bucket al fresco?

Listen, we know that red wine has greater depth and complexity, that white wine gives greater terroir, that sparkling is more elegant. It's just that rose is so fun, so beautiful in the glass, so varied in style (and, if we're being honest, such good value) that we think it's worth celebrating.

Most winemaking regions produce rose, and we've sought to highlight the entire spectrum, as it were, of rose from around the globe. For example, the Heidi Schrock is so dark that it could be mistaken for a light red, while the La Spinetta has only the slightest blush. Smells and flavors are equally diverse – the Roquefort Grenache Blend smells like cotton candy and tastes like strawberries and mint, contrasted with the Heitz Grignolino, which has black cherry up front and smoky undertones.

Sunshine and rose don't last forever, though, so enjoy this great combination while you can...

FRIENDLY & REFRESHING REDS

RED BURGUNDY

Pinot Noir from the French region of Burgundy is not so much loved as worshipped. Cases from the best vineyards in the best vintages get auctioned off for tens of thousands of dollars; and wine critics write paeans full of phrases like ‘Its bouquet is redolent of animal, spice notes, underbrush, and prune, evolving with age towards musk, leather, fur and mushroom.’ It can be a little intimidating, to say the least.

But if we step back from the pomp and circumstance, we see that there is a reason these wines have become so prized. Few other places in the world can consistently produce red wines with such elegance and balance, or with such a range of styles and flavors. And all of this is produced exclusively from Pinot Noir. What’s more, it can be uniquely versatile among red wines at the table. No matter if the particular bottle is pretty and floral (à la the 2012 Desertaux-Ferrand), light and fruity (the 2010 Magnien Morey-Saint-Denis), or earthy and chewy (2007 Meo-Camuzet Echezeaux) – the tannin and acidity will be so well balanced that it can pair with everything from sole to sirloin.

Just be forewarned – you might start writing poetry and emptying your savings.

Hell, even when he isn’t working with Zinfandel, his style leans towards the primal and massive. The Petite Sirahs are not petite – they are Falstaffian. That Ueberroth Vineyard is 16.2% alcohol and is sleek, powerful and dark as a sex panther—yet the alcohol is totally in balance with the fruit and acid. (And yes, that is an *Anchorman* reference.)

While one can dine at Stone Park, we ourselves like to eat. Thick pork chops, big steaks with liberal servings of asparagus – it’s just how we roll. When we tuck in to big, boldly flavored meals, it makes us happy to have a big, boldly flavored wine at hand. Hence our love of Larry Turley and his magically anti-subtle wines.
